



Top 15 National Amateur Tournament, The Dogwood Invitational Set for June 23-28th
Dogwood Returns for 48th Year with AT&T as Sponsor

ATLANTA – March 12, 2014 – [The Dogwood Invitational](#) at Druid Hills Golf Club, held since 1941, will host their 48th annual tournament from Monday, June 23 – Saturday, June 28, 2014, continuing its vision to propel today’s amateurs into their professional golf careers.

This year’s tournament is shaping up to be another fine week on the links as the 2013 Dogwood champion, Michael Johnson from Auburn University, will be returning to defend his title. Last year, Johnson shot a final round 64 to finish the tournament at a tournament record 28 under par securing his title as champion of the 47th annual Dogwood Invitational by seven shots and shattering Andrew Buckle’s 2002 tournament record of 23 under.

AT&T will also be returning for their seventh consecutive year as The Dogwood’s platinum sponsor. Each year, the tournament dedicates proceeds from sponsorship dollars to local charities whose mission, vision and goals align with those of the invitational.
