Druid Hills Golf Club to Host Men's Elite from Amateur Circuit

ATLANTA – June 19, 2014 – This year, The Dogwood Invitational, ranked as one of the top 15 amateur golf tournaments in the nation, and one of the top 30 in the world, announced today that it has secured several of the top male amateur golfers, as ranked by *GolfWeek's* amateurgolf.com, for the 2014 tournament. With 83 players vying for the coveted trophy, The Dogwood Invitational will be held from June 23 – June 28, 2014 at Druid Hills Golf Club in Atlanta, which has hosted the tournament and a fine slate of amateur golfers since 1941.
