ATLANTA – June 29, 2016 – The first round of The Dogwood Invitational was completed today and Jimmy Jones of Florida Southern and Nathan Jeansonne of LSU both fired an eight under par 64 to be joint first place. Jacob Joiner of Georgia Tech is second at six under with a 66. There are 7 players joint third at 5 under par.

Scoring conditions were perfect with the greens receptive from the previous days 1.2 inches of rain. Play continues Wednesday with the second round at 7:30 am.
